## OUR RING SIZE GUIDE

Ring size is determined by inner diameter, not circumference.
To find yours, cut a thin piece of paper and wrap it around your finger, keeping it close to your bottom knuckle. Mark where the paper meets and measure its length with a ruler. US 7 is the standard ring size. Measurements below in millimeters.

## OPTION 1

Please print this guide to $100 \%$ scaled on US letter-size ( $8.5^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ ) paper and match one of your rings to a circle below. The scale is correct if a credit card is the same length as the line below. You are a half size if you ring falls in between two fo the circles.



US SIZE 6
16.4 mm inner diameter


US SIZE 7
17.4 mm inner diameter


US SIZE 8
18.2 mm inner diameter

## OPTION 2

Carefully cut out the ruler and make a small slit on the dotted line on the left end of the sizer. Wrap the ruler around the finger with the number facing out. The number that lines up with the slit comfortably represents your ring size.
